DO meaning: 1 : to perform (an action or activity); 2 : used with what to ask or talk about a person's job

Do is one of three auxiliary verbs in English: be, do, have. We use do to make negatives (do + not), to make question forms, and to make the verb more emphatic.

To do is to act, perform, or undertake. When you do chores, you engage in the activity of cleaning the kitchen or taking out the trash. Do is one of the most frequently used verbs in English.

As a verb, "do" means to perform, carry out, or execute an action. It's one of the most common verbs in English, used in a wide range of contexts, from simple tasks to ...

To behave or conduct oneself; act: Do as I say and you won't get into trouble. To get along; fare: students who do well at school. To carry on; manage: I could do without your ...

DO definition: to perform (an act, duty, role, etc.). See examples of do used in a sentence.

The meaning of DO is to bring to pass : carry out. How to use do in a sentence. Feasible and Doable

When you do something, you take some action or perform an activity or task. Do is often used instead of a more specific verb, to talk about a common action involving a particular thing.
