Which plug sockets can be used in Estonia?

Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets. Typically, type C plug sockets are not allowed to be installed in Estonia: these outlets are not earthed and are therefore considered dangerous. Only type F power points are permitted because they are grounded and therefore significantly safer.

Do I need a power adapter in Estonia?

Even if the voltage in your home country is the same as in Estonia, you may still need a power adapter. This is because the shape of the electrical outlets in Estonia is different from the shape of the outlets in many other countries. A power adapter will allow you to plug your devices into the Estonian outlets.

Are the power outlets and plugs in Estonia the same?

However, the power outlets and plugs in Estonia are not the same as those found in many other countries. It is important to bring a power adapter that is compatible with the Estonian power system to avoid damaging your electronic devices.

What is the voltage in Estonia?

Just like the rest of Europe, the voltage in Estonia is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Estonia has standardized on type F sockets and plugs. Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets.

Estonia uses Type C/F electrical outlets with standard voltage of 230V and 50Hz frequency. If your device plugs don't match Estonia's standards, we recommend purchasing suitable travel ...
