Who is Tunisie Telecom?

Tunisie Telecom is the incumbent telecom operator in Tunisia. Tunisie Telecom has more than 6 million subscribers in the fixed and mobile telephony, in Tunisia and abroad. Tunisie Telecom has an important role in improving the rate of internet penetration in Tunisia, which allowed it to have 140,000 subscribers at the end of April 2008.

Who controls the mobile services market in Tunisia?

Four major operators control the mobile services market. Tunisia's largest telecom company is Ooredoo (Orascom Telecom Tunisia). In 2022, Tunisie Telecom had 39.7% of the market, Ooredoo 37.4%, and Orange Tunisie 22.9%. Lycamobile had an insignificant market share.

Does Tunisia have a competitive market for foreign companies?

The playing field for foreign companies operating in Tunisia remains fair, with no evident competitive advantage for the state-owned telecom company, Tunisie Telecom. Four major operators control the mobile services market. Tunisia's largest telecom company is Ooredoo (Orascom Telecom Tunisia).

Can Tunisia expand its bandwidth?

Tunisia is considering various options to further expand its bandwidth and is exploring a new submarine cable project that would connect Tunisia's northern town of Bizerte to Marseille in France. In 2009, Tunisia awarded the first third-generation (3G) mobile license to Orange Tunisie, followed by Tunisie Telecom in 2010 and Ooredoo in 2012.
